I. REMOVE CURRENT LEG ASSEMBLIES

- Step 1** Remove the Y-connector (1).
- Step 2** Remove lower pins (2).
- Step 3** Remove nuts (3).
- Step 4** Cut hoses (4) at least 1.5" back from the end of the connector.

- Step 5** Remove the 12 Philips screws (5).

- Step 6** Remove the bottom cover (6).

- Step 7** Remove and retain the two stainless steel sleeves (7).

- Step 8** Remove the left and right standard width legs (8) with the hose assembly.

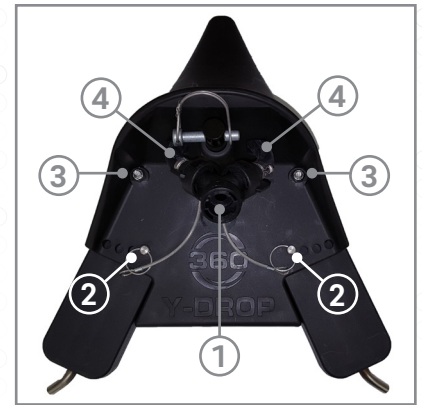

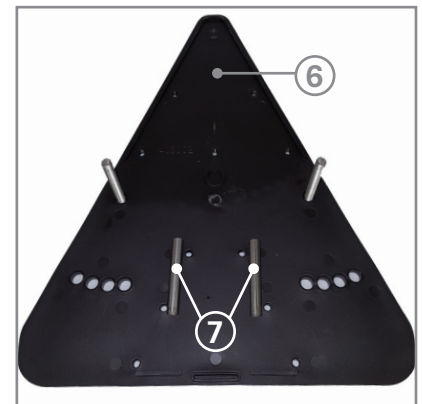

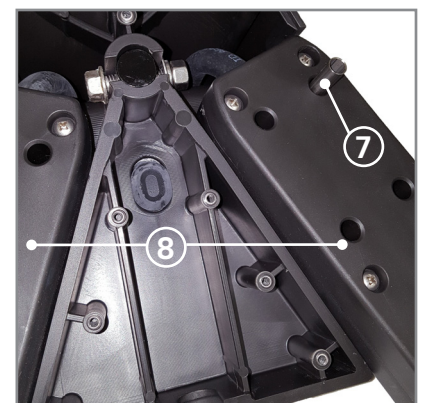

II. INSTALL NARROW LEG ASSEMBLIES

- Step 1** Place the Left and Right narrow leg assemblies (9) on the base unit.
- Step 2** Route the hose assemblies through the top of the base unit.
- Step 3** Reinstall stainless steel sleeves (7).

- Step 4** Reinstall the bottom cover (6).
- Step 5** Reinstall the flange bolts (10).

- Step 6** Reinstall nuts (3) and tighten until the top of the base is seated against the leg and can still freely rotate.

- Step 6** Install the supplied 12 screws.

WARNING: Install screws by hand. Use of drills and impacts could result in stripping out the threads.

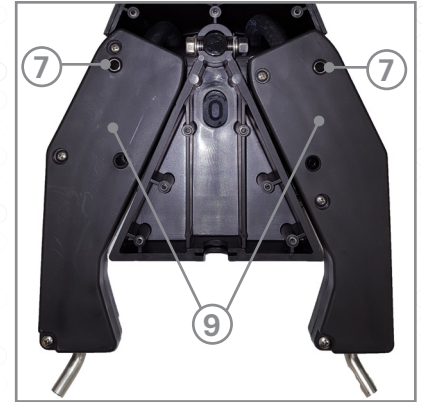

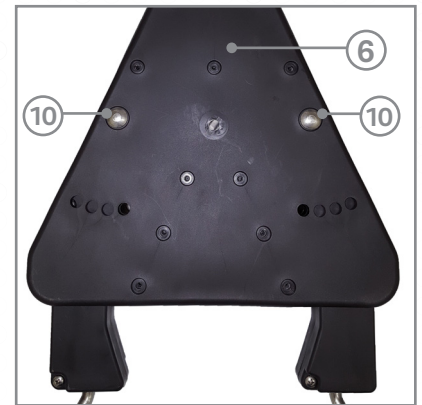

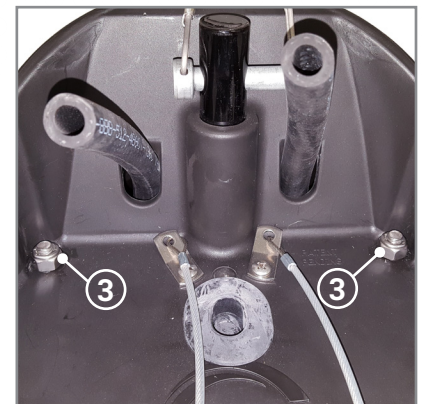

III. REMOVING THE OETIKER CLAMP

Step 1 Straighten the tab (11) in order to allow the flap (12) to be opened.

Step 2 Pry open the flap and remove the clamp (13).

Step 3 Cut the hose lengthwise (14).
NOTE: use extreme caution when making the cut. Gloves and eye protection should be used.

Step 4 Repeat steps 1-4 for the Quick Connect Fitting.

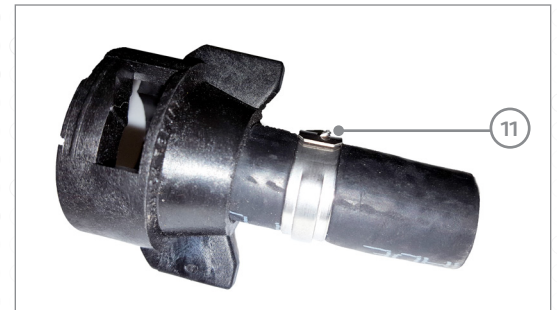

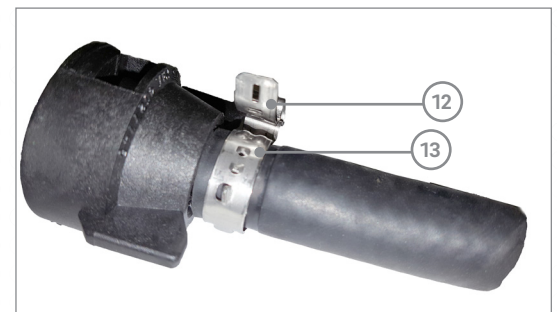

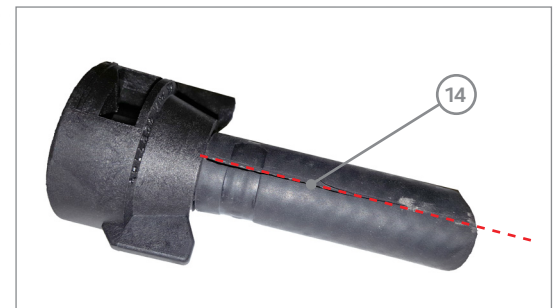

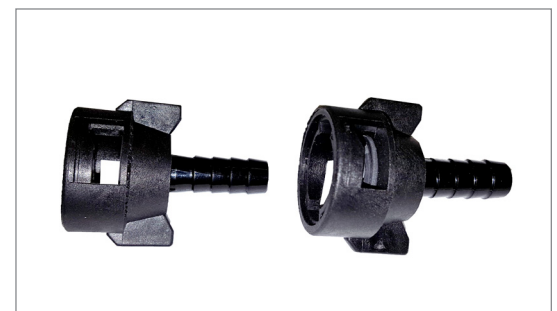

IV. REINSTALLING THE QUICK CONNECT FITTINGS AND Y-CONNECTOR

Step 1 Install the barbed fittings (15) on the hose assemblies (16).

Step 2 Install the supplied clamps (17).

NOTE: Be sure to reinstall the rubber washers inside the quick connect fitting.

Step 3 Reinstall the Y-Connector (1).

Step 4 Trim the outside of the bottom plate to match the profile of the narrow leg (18).

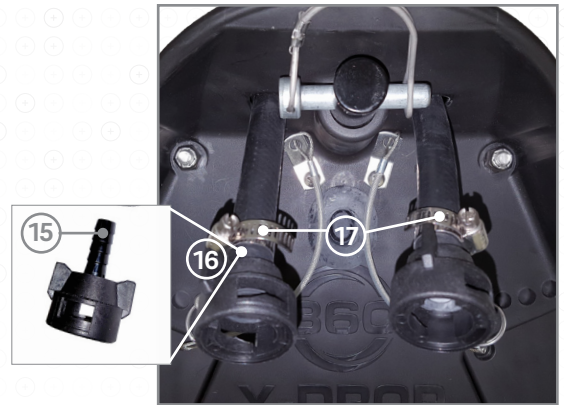

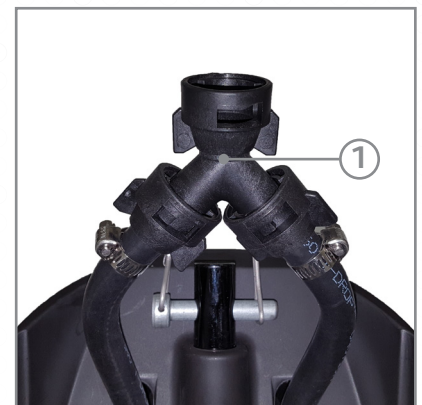
